I'm at a point where I want to test it on my real phone (which is not rooted) as well as test it in the Android emulator. My idea is to test out a basic server side with PHP (I have experience in this), and then use the "remote web service" Android app that is included in the SDK which uses GZIP compression so it can save data and be mobile. My question is, can I tie in the authentication to both the real and emulator versions of the app? So, if I visit my site it will authenticate and tell me I can be this site's client. I've thought of this, but I'm not really sure how to proceed. A: My idea is to test out a basic server side with PHP (I have experience in this). Ah, PHP. Well, that's... interesting. The Android SDK contains a web client sample that involves, among other things, the ability to pass credentials to a web server in the same app and have the credentials be remembered between sessions. The sample is C2DM, and so is C2DM-enabled only for testing purposes. I don't think it can be used with regular C2DM, but that might be wrong.
