Her other roles include Daisy on the Showtime drama series, The Affair, and the fantasy series, The Magicians. She is of Russian-Jewish descent. Career In 2015, Rubell made her film debut in the science fiction film, Tusk, as the lead character, Lindsay. She also appeared in Den of Thieves (2017) and as a romantic lead in the horror film, The Strangers: Prey at Night (2020). In 2019, she appeared in Love, Simon, as Mandy, a trans teen. In 2016, she appeared in Hulu's Casual as Daphne Beckett. She also appeared on the 2015 Oxygen reality series, Oxygen's Elite 11, where she and the other cast members had to identify celebrities. She has performed in three Kids Company community events, including a performance as Abigail Nash, where she had to play a deceased child, in the 2017 production of Gore Vidal's The Best Man. She portrayed Julie in the 2017 film adaptation of the audio drama, 13 Reasons Why, based on the 2007 American teen suicide drama, of the same name.
